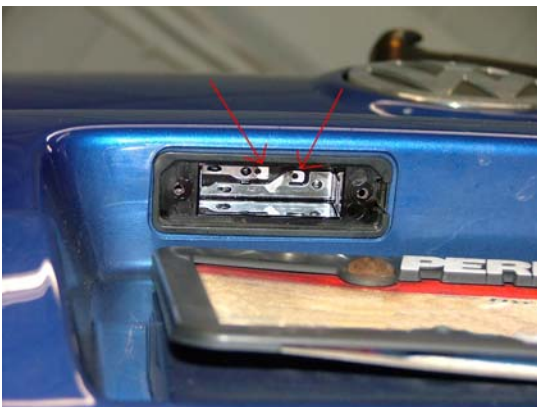


ECS MKV LED License Plate Light Installation Instructions

When installing your new LED bulbs make sure that the LED board is facing down in the lamp assembly and that it is securely in place.



Note: In some vehicles it may be necessary to bend two tabs upwards inside of the lamp housing to accommodate the slightly larger bulb with heat sink. (See Picture) MKV Volkswagens are almost always in need of this change to avoid premature bulb failure. Check to make sure if this is required for your vehicle otherwise your new bulbs may be damaged.



Also, these bulbs are polarity sensitive. If installed incorrectly the bulbs will not light. If this is the case simply flip the direction of the bulb in lamp.
